SUBJECT	Computation of Deadlines and Time Limits		

1. **Purpose.** The Class Action Settlement Agreement in *In re Sulzer Hip Prosthesis and Knee Prosthesis Product Liability Litigation* ("Settlement Agreement") mandates time limits and deadlines that govern the performance of certain acts or make certain applications by Class Members, the Claims Administrator, or other individuals or entities. This Claims Administrator Procedure ("CAP") establishes how the Claims Administrator shall calculate the occurrence and passage of such time limits and deadlines. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this CAP shall have the meanings given them in the Settlement Agreement.

2. **Computation of Time Deadlines and Limits.** In computing any period of time prescribed or allowed by the Settlement Agreement, the day of the act, event, or default from which the designated period of time begins to run shall not be included. The last day of the period so computed shall be included, unless it is a Saturday, a Sunday, or a legal holiday, or, when the act to be done is the filing of a paper in the Court, a day on which weather or other conditions have made the office of the Clerk of the District Court for the Northern District of Ohio, in Cleveland, Ohio, inaccessible, in which event the period runs until the end of the next day which is not one of the aforementioned days. "Legal holiday" includes New Year's Day, Birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr., Washington's Birthday, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and any other day appointed as a holiday by the President or the Congress of the United States, or by the State of Ohio.


3. **Fixing Date of Trial Court Approval.** Trial Court Approval, as defined in Settlement Agreement Section 1.1(tttt), occurred on May 8, 2002.

4. **Claims Administrator Not Estopped by Time Limits and Deadlines.** This CAP shall not alter the applicability of Section 4.6(a) of the Settlement Agreement, which provides in pertinent part that the "[f]ailure on the part of the Claims Administrator to meet any of the deadlines set forth [in this Settlement Agreement] or subsequently established shall not be deemed to render a claim completed or otherwise entitle a Class Member to benefits hereunder, unless otherwise so ordered by the Court after notice and hearing."

5. **Duration of this CAP.** This CAP shall apply from the Effective Date stated above and shall terminate upon the earlier of: (i) cancellation or modification of this CAP by the Claims Administrator, or (ii) an order of the Court canceling or modifying the terms of this CAP.


