

<b>SULZER SETTLEMENT TRUST CLAIMS ADMINISTRATOR PROCEDURE</b>

<b>SUBJECT</b>	<b>Clarifying Timeliness Requirements for Amendments and Supplements of Certain Extraordinary Injury Fund Claims.</b>		

1. **Purpose.** Section 4.6(a) of the Settlement Agreement provides that Class Members who seek Extraordinary Injury Fund benefits must submit a Green Form to claim those benefits and prescribes certain deadlines for making Claims depending upon the nature of the Claim. The Green Form further provides that Class Members must elect the Matrix Level benefits they seek. This Claims Administrator Procedure ("CAP") clarifies how the Claims Administrator shall determine whether an EIF Claim is timely submitted where Claimants, supplement, amend, or otherwise modify ("Amend" or "Amendment") their election during the claims administration process. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this Claims Administrator Procedure ("CAP") shall have the meaning given them in the Settlement Agreement.

2. **Relation Back of Amendments to EIF Claim.** If a Class Member Amends an EIF Claim, after submitting a Green Form, but before the end of the time permitted to contest a Preliminary Determination for all injuries alleged in that Green Form, the Amendment shall be deemed to relate back to the date the Green Form was submitted.

3. **Timeliness of Claims Made in an Amendment.** The Amendment shall be deemed timely if the Claim embodied in the Amendment would have been timely, in accordance with the terms of the Settlement Agreement, if submitted by the date on which the Class Member submitted the applicable Green Form. The Amendment shall be deemed to give rise to a timely Claim even if a Class Member submits the Amendment on a date that is later than that permitted by the Settlement Agreement if the Class Member submitted the Claim without having first submitted the Green Form to which the Amendment relates back. For example, a Class Member with a November 4, 2002 deadline to submit any Green Form timely submits a Green Form seeking Matrix Level IV benefits. The Class Member may then later Amend his submission on January 4, 2003 to also allege a NAPRS so long as the Amendment is submitted before the last day to contest a Preliminary Determination related to the November 4, 2002 Green Form.


4. **Method of Amendment.** A Class Member seeking to Amend a Green Form, as provided by this CAP, must do so in writing by either submitting a letter or supplemental Green Form, the content of which provides notice to the Claims Administrator, with reasonable specificity, of the Claim and Matrix Level alleged.

5. **Finality of EIF Determinations.** Once the time to Amend a Green Form has expired, pursuant to Paragraph 2 of this CAP, no further Amendments may be made to a Green Form submission. An EIF Claim made after the time permitted in Paragraph 2 of this CAP may not relate back to the submission date of a previous Green Form as provided in Paragraphs 2 and 3 of this CAP.

6. **Duration of this CAP.** This CAP shall be effective from the Effective Date stated above and shall terminate upon the earlier of: (i) cancellation or modification of this CAP by the Claims Administrator, or (ii) an order of the Court canceling or modifying the terms of this CAP.


