SUBJECT	Board Certification for Physician Declaration		

1. **Purpose.** The Settlement Agreement provides that Class Members may submit a Physician Declaration form in support of their Claims for Affected Product Revision Surgery Fund benefits and/or Extraordinary Injury Fund benefits. This Claims Administrator Procedure ("CAP") clarifies when a physician who completes a Physician Declaration form must also submit a board certification as part of his or her submission. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this CAP shall have the meaning given them in the Settlement Agreement.

2. **When Board Certification Is Required.** Treating physicians or surgeons who complete a Physician Declaration need not include a copy of their Board Certification with their Physician Declaration. Any doctor other than a treating physician who completes a Physician Declaration, must (i) be board certified in the area of expertise in which he or she is providing evidence, (ii) be certified must be by a national certifying body, and (iii) attach a copy of his or her board certification.

3. **Duration of this CAP.** This CAP shall be effective from the Effective Date stated above and shall terminate upon the earlier of: (i) cancellation or modification of this CAP by the Claims Administrator, or (ii) an order of the Court canceling or modifying the terms of this CAP.
